

Chennai Trade Recovery

Notice to Trade

Feeder Operator are monitoring the precarious situation at Chennai which has already resulted in a backlog of shipments, a fall down in productivity levels and delayed vessel schedules.

Despite various local approaches to seek solutions, the trailer congestion continues both inside the port (imports trying to evacuate) and outside the port entrance (Export movements waiting to enter).

All traffic is being routed through one gate and appeals to re-open gates 2&2A have yet to achieve any success.

With mounting cost exposure, and continuing poor road connectivity conditions to the CFS locations (which will only be worsened by the imminent monsoon season) the future remains very uncertain.

According, unless there is an immediate improvement and return to normalcy by 15th August 2011, Chennai Feeder Operators will have no option than to re-introduce a Chennai Trade Recovery (CTR).

Hence Logwin will have to charge a **CHENNAI TRADE RECOVERY** until further notice.
